# Plan

## Phase I

\$3.9 Million for Building and Site development  
(water, sewer, traffic lanes, etc.)

\$1.2 Million for refinancing of current property

\$150 Thousand for 1.25 acre parcel adjacent to our property  
= \$5,250,000.

## Phase II

\$2.6 Million for Banquet Hall & Retail Space

\$4.8 Million for Worship Cathedral

\$2.6 Million for Administration and Classroom

\$1.8 Million Further Site Development

\$1.0 Million Day Care/Elder Care

Projected Phase II = \$12.8 million

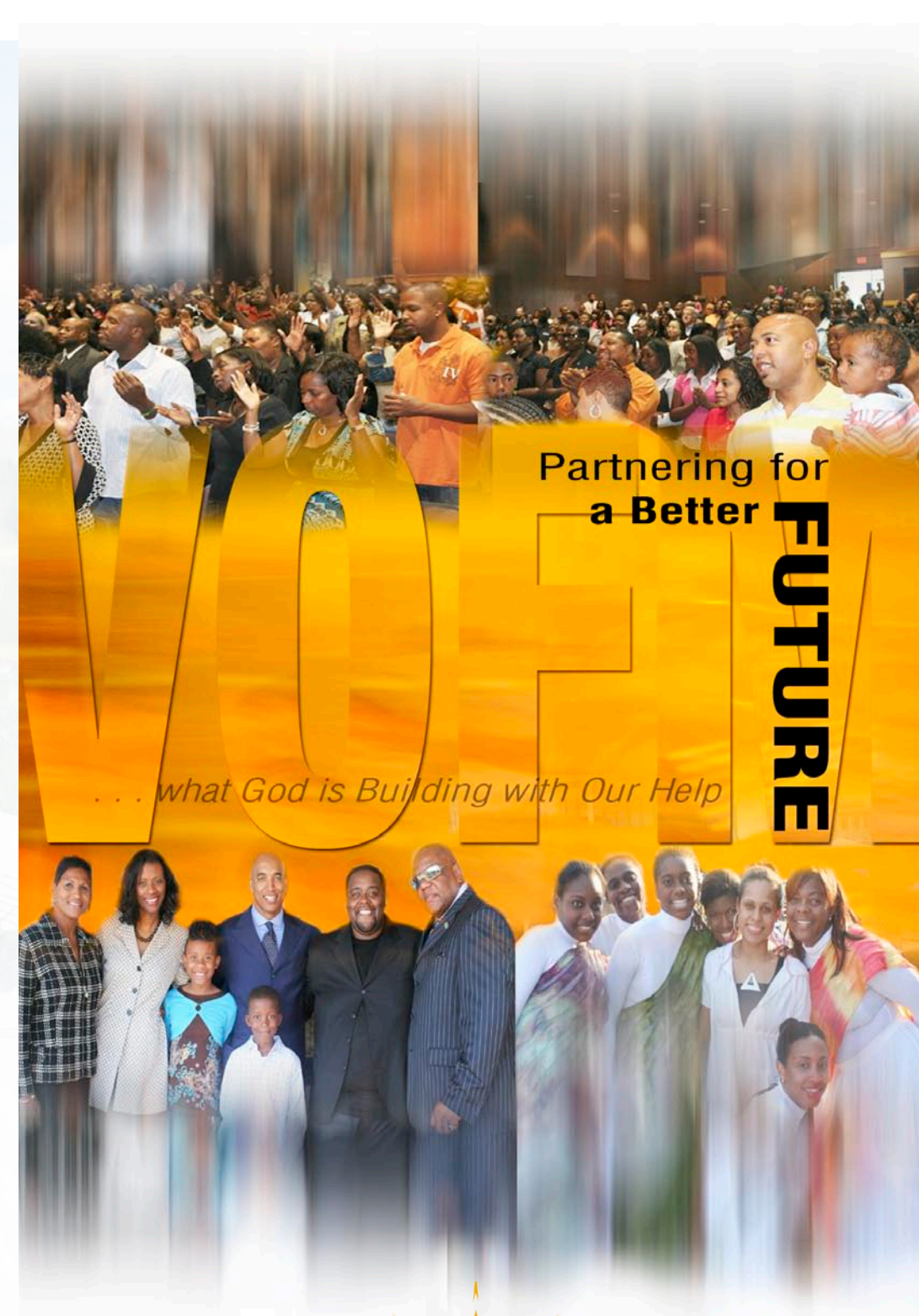

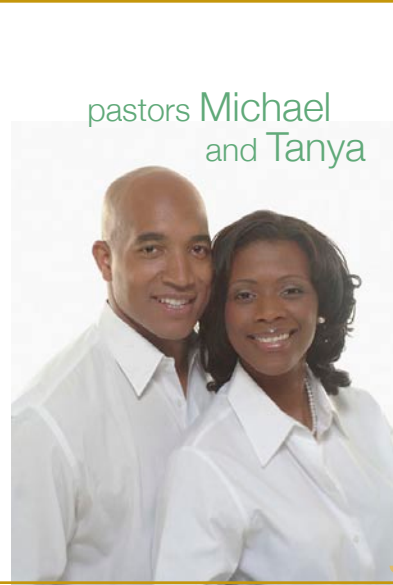

Dear Friends,

In 1998 Pastor Tanya & I moved to Richmond, VA when Jocelyn was only 1 month old. We came so I could attend seminary and get a Masters of Divinity degree to prepare me for the pastorate. Seven years later with a call on both of our lives to plant a church that would change the world, God launched the Village of Faith Ministries on December 5, 2005. With

a vision to “Reach families with a simple gospel message that will help them change the world”, we set out about this mission going door to door to share our story.

With 44 members joining on the first day and averaging over 200 people in attendance after only two months, we changed locations to the local high school and that’s when the flood gates of heaven opened. We purchased 18.25 acres of land in Eastern Henrico. We started our first television broadcast, put up billboards, started several ministries and within one year over 400 people called themselves members of the Village of Faith.

During our second year of ministry it was our vision to be one church in two locations. So on Easter Sunday of 2007 we launched our second location in an adjacent county. On that Sunday between both locations we ministered to over 1,300 people. Our Village Values of “Celebrating Life, Empowering Individuals, Impacting Communities and Sharing Our Faith” have driven our members to soar to higher heights. Members are getting out of debt, starting businesses and seeing dreams fulfilled.

As we look to the future, we are thankful for what God has built and excited for what God is going to build through all of us. We know that we cannot do it alone. To accomplish this God sized task, we know that “It will Take a Village”...
